About the Journal

The "E-Journal on Advanced Research in Intellectual Property Laws" will be an annual student edited, double-blind peer reviewed open-access journal, which is an initiative by the members of Centre for Advanced Research in Intellectual Property Laws (CARIP), NLUJAA. Through this journal, we are proposing to create a fair and equitable regime in regards to intellectual property law and also to analyse the dynamic confluence of the academic and the transactional world presented by these laws.

Our main objective is to build a global initiative for research and development in the area of Intellectual Property Laws. This online journal will predominantly put emphasis and focus on various contemporary, critical and often overlooked areas of intellectual property law which in turn is affecting the formulation, regulation and implementation of law and policy in this area.

We invite contributions from practitioners in the legal profession, undergraduate and post-graduate students, researchers, academicians and other stake holders in the form of articles, essays, notes, commentaries and reviews for the forthcoming issue.

Subject Area:

The submissions may relate to any field in IPR including Trademarks, Copyright, GI, Designs, Patent, Plant Varieties or other related contemporary IPR issues.

We seek contributions in the following forms:

- Articles (between 3,000-7,000 words including footnotes).
- Essays (2000-3000 words including footnotes).
- Book Reviews (1000-2000 words including footnotes).
- Case Commentaries (1000-3000 words including footnotes).

Content Guidelines.

1. All submissions must be made through e-mails to ejcarip@nluassam.ac.in in the form of an attachment in .doc or .docx (MS Word format). The subject of the email must be edited as provided below:

2. All submissions must be accompanied by a cover letter containing ,
 - i) Title of the paper/essays/reviews/commentaries
 - ii) Name(s) of the author(s),
 - iii) Designation, including the institution/affiliation,
 - iv) The contact information (correspondence address, email, and phone number).
3. The submission must also include an abstract of not more than 250 words.
4. The submissions must conform to the prescribed word limit. The prescribed word limits are exclusive of footnotes and abstract.

5. The formatting shall be according to the following parameters:

a) Main Text and Headings:

- Font – Times New Roman
- Font size - 12
- Line spacing - 1.5
- Margin – 1" from all sides.

b) Footnotes:

- Font – Times New Roman
- Font size – 10
- Line Spacing – 1

6. All citations shall be in accordance with The Bluebook: A Uniform System of Citation 19th Ed.

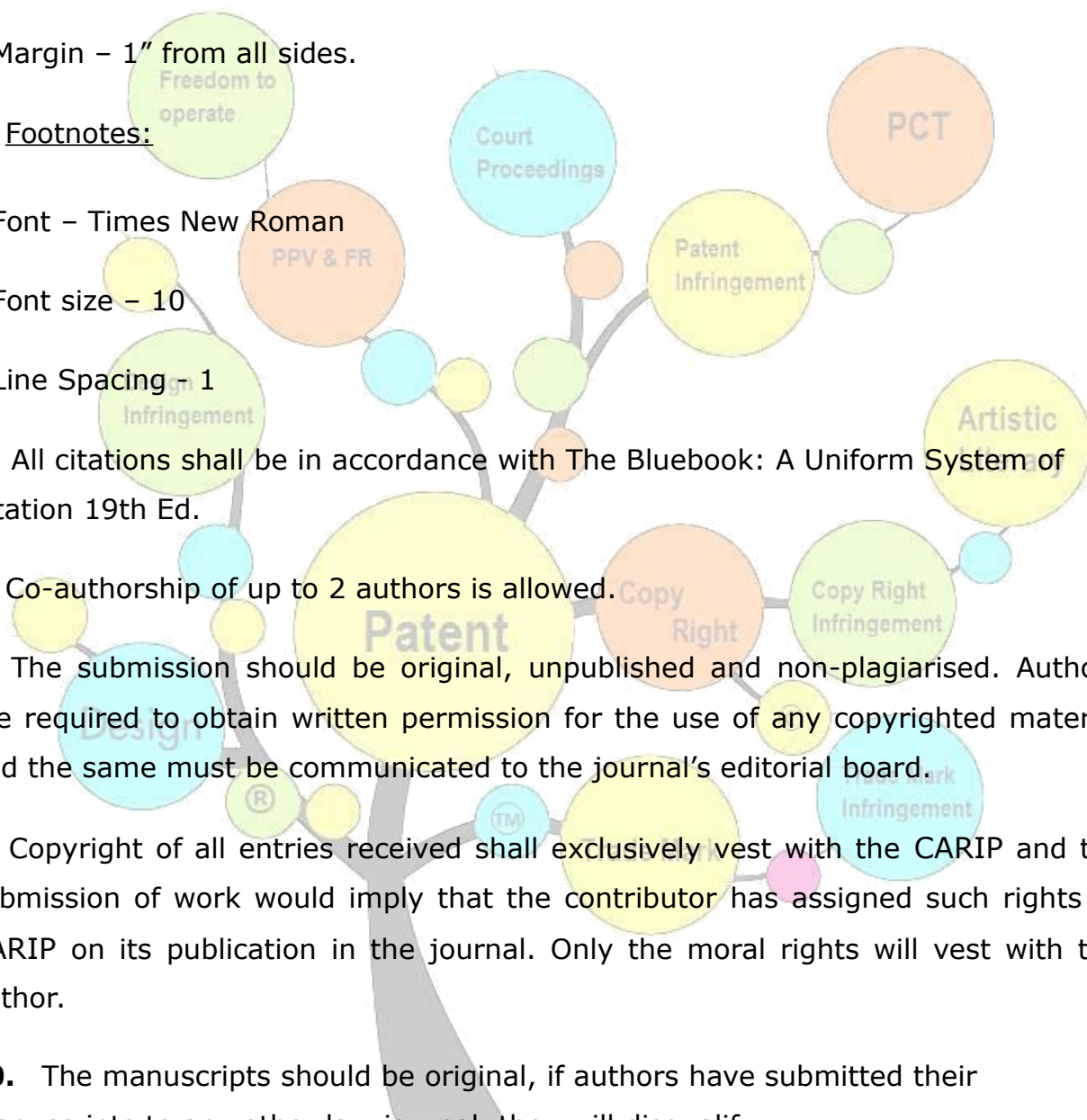
7. Co-authorship of up to 2 authors is allowed.

8. The submission should be original, unpublished and non-plagiarised. Authors are required to obtain written permission for the use of any copyrighted material and the same must be communicated to the journal's editorial board.

9. Copyright of all entries received shall exclusively vest with the CARIP and the submission of work would imply that the contributor has assigned such rights to CARIP on its publication in the journal. Only the moral rights will vest with the author.

10. The manuscripts should be original, if authors have submitted their manuscripts to any other law journal, they will disqualify.

11. Editorial Board reserves the exclusive right to take the decision to publish the contribution or not.
