

Prof. R. P. Anand scholarship for Tilu Linggi



Tilu Linggi, a student of Master of Laws (LL.M.) from the **National Law University and Judicial Academy, Assam**, who basically hails from a small town, Roing in Arunachal Pradesh, has been selected as the proud recipient of the 2014 RP Anand Scholarship alongwith another student from the National Law School of India University, Bangalore. The scholarship, valued at Rs 60,000 is aimed at providing financial assistance to the students pursuing their Post Graduate studies in International Law intensely scrutinized by a panel of the Virtual Centre of International Law (VCIL) and is accompanied by a certificate along with some books written by the Late Prof. R.P. Anand.

The RP Anand Scholarship was founded by the RP Anand Virtual Centre of International Law (VCIL). The creation of the RP Anand VCIL is inspired by the life, teachings and writings of the Late Prof. R.P. Anand. He was one of the pioneers of the Third World Approaches to International Law (TWAIL), and is widely recognized and respected as a spokesman of the Third World views on the subject. Prof. Anand was the President of the prestigious Indian Society of International Law and also a Vice President of the Asian Society of International Law.
