## Oil & Gas Law (For Law Undergraduate Students in India)

#### **Course Objectives:**

- Examine the legal framework for oil and gas transportation through pipelines, focusing on rights-of-way, common carrier obligations, and tariff determination.
- Analyze the legal framework for marketing and sale of oil and gas products, including pricing mechanisms, regulatory controls, and competition law considerations.

 Develop legal research and writing skills through case studies and analysis of relevant legislation and contracts.

#### **Course Structure:**

#### Module 1: Introduction to Oil & Gas Law in India

- Fundamentals of Oil & Gas: Understanding the nature and classification of oil and gas resources, their exploration techniques, and the global oil and gas market.
- **Constitutional Framework:** Examining the Constitutional provisions governing ownership and exploitation of oil and gas resources in India.
- The Legal Landscape: Identifying key legislation governing oil and gas E&P activities in India, such as the Oil Fields (Regulation and Development) Act, 1947, and the Petroleum and Natural Gas Regulatory Board Act, 1993.

#### Module 2: Ownership and Regulatory Regime

- State Ownership and Public Sector Undertakings (PSUs): Analyzing the role of the Government of India and PSUs like ONGC and OIL in oil and gas exploration and production.
- Regulatory Framework: Understanding the role of the Ministry of Petroleum and Natural Gas (MoPNG) and the Directorate General of Hydrocarbons (DGH) in regulating oil and gas E&P activities.
- Environmental Regulations: Examining environmental regulations applicable to oil and gas E&P activities, including environmental impact assessments and pollution control norms.
