SCOPE OF WORK:

The scope of work and terms and conditions related to Statutory Audit of the books of account of the University is outlined hereunder:

The Statutory Audit will be carried out in accordance with the Indian Accounting Standards and will include tests and controls, as the auditors feel necessary under the circumstances. The major areas to be covered are as under: -

1. Statutory Audit to cover the following areas ensuring that,

- a) transactions are recorded as per Indian Accounting Standards and are booked to proper accounting heads.
- b) goods and services have been procured in compliance with law.
- c) transactions are duly supported by proper supporting documents.
- d) propriety of transactions is maintained.
- e) checking the maintenance of books of accounts and records.
- f) checking the bank reconciliation statements.
- g) checking of component wise, category-wise and account head wise expenditures.
- h) checking of investments, short term deposit etc. made from time to time.
- i) checking of various taxes/statutory compliances.
- j) verification of fixed deposit records and checking of interest received.
- k) checking of all record registers including Minute Books and to see that accounting effects of all the decisions taken at General Meeting/Board of Governors Meeting /Audit Committee Meeting are given in the Books of Account.
- l) to provide executive summary of audit exercise incorporating all points/matters: which are of very important nature.

2. Audit of Financial Books

Audit of Financial Books to ensure:

- a) verification of Bank Book Journal, Vouching of Imprest Cash.
- b) scrutiny of General Ledger, Staff Advance Registers, commenting on loan outstanding entries, etc.
- c) verification of cash, cheques on hand etc.
- d) verification of all computer vouchers and sheets ensure correct coding and accounting head.
- e) scrutiny of general ledger and Verification of Income and Expenditure Statement, and Balance sheet and other Schedules.
- f) serification of Salary/ Consultancy payments, P.F, LT., TDS, etc., and verification of submission of various return to the competent authority in time.
- g) verification of all financial information completely, promptly and after the necessary authorisation was recorded.



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3. Accounting Policy & Standard

The auditor shall endeavour:

The auditors may make specific observations with respect to the efficiency of financial procedure, the accounting system and in general, the administration and management of the organization.
