Announcement for Students Admitted to One Year LL.M. Degree Programme and B.A., LL. B(Hons.) FYIC in Academic Year 2026-27.

Students admitted to the P.G and U.G Courses of the University in the Academic Year 2026-27 are to note the following:

- **Verification of original documents will take place on August 3 and 4, 2026, at the Seminar Room, Floor II, Administrative Block for U.G and Moot Court Hall, Floor I for P.G of the University.**

Students shall report with all original testimonials and annexures, along with self-attested photocopies of the same (1 set) for verification. Notarized affidavits & annexures shall be submitted to the University during the verification process. “The link for the annexures is attached.”

Required Testimonials, Certificates & Annexures for The P.G. Programme at The Time of Document Verification:

- A. Grade 10 statement of marks,**
- B. CLAT 2026 Admit and Score Card,**
- C. Grade 12 statement of marks,**
- D. LL.B./B.L./Equivalent Degree Statement of Marks,**
- E. Character Certificate/Conduct Certificate from the Educational Institute last attended,**
- F. Transfer/Migration Certificate from the Educational Institute last attended,**
- G. Cast Certificate (SC, ST, OBC NCL etc.) if applied under the Reserved category of seat,**
- H. PWD/ SAP Certificate, if allotted under PWD Category,**
- I. Documents to claim seat for Ward of Defence Personnel, EWS categories and Ward of Jammu & Kashmir Migrant.**
- J. For OBC (NCL)/EWS categories, certificates need to be produced for the current year.**
- K. Candidates allotted seats under the domicile/resident category seat are to submit Permanent Residence Certificate (PRC).**
- L. A Gap Certificate (Self declaration legal document through court affidavit) must be submitted at the time of document verification only by candidates who have a break of 1 or more years between their last completed qualification and the new admission at NLUJA, Assam. This gap certificate must be printed on non-judicial stamp paper and attested by an authorized Notary Public or an Oath Commissioner.**
- M. Annexure 1-A and Annexure 1-B must be duly notarized on non –judicial stamp paper of Rs 100/- by an authorized notary public or an authorized oath commissioner.**
- N. Annexure-II (Medical Certificate) must be signed by at least a state or central government-registered MBBS medical practitioner before submission by the candidate.**

- O. Annexure – III (Temporary Undertaking Form) is required if any original testimonial from Sl. No. A to K is unavailable. This annexure is valid only for a limited time, as specified within the form. Candidates must submit the self-attested photocopy of their original testimonials to the university before this validity period expires.
- P. Annexure – IV (Hostel Accommodation Application Form) must be signed by the candidate and their parent and then submit it at the time of document verification.
- Q. Annexure – V (Local Guardian Form) must be signed by the candidate's local guardian and submitted by the candidate at the time of document verification. In the absence of a local guardian, the candidate's parent must sign the form.
- R. Annexure – VI (Temporary Undertaking form for P.G Candidates whose final Year LL. B results are awaited) must be submitted only by those P.G. candidates who have not yet received their LL.B./B.L. or equivalent degree statement of marks because their results are awaited. Candidates must submit self-attested photocopies of their original testimonials to the university upon receiving their degree from their respective institution.
- S. Annexure-VII (Anti Ragging Affidavit): A printed copy of the undertaking, submitted online by the candidate and their parent, must be presented at the time of document verification. The link for the online undertaking is provided within the annexure.
- T. Annexure-VIII (Specialization Course Option Form for the 1-Year LL.M. Degree Programme) must be submitted physically by the candidate at the time of document verification. Additionally, a soft copy of the form must be emailed in advance to exam@nluassam.ac.in, with a carbon copy (CC) to dipsikhadas@nluassam.ac.in.

- C. Grade 12 statement of marks,

- E. Transfer/Migration Certificate from the Educational Institute last attended,
- F. Cast Certificate (SC, ST, OBC NCL etc.) if allotted under the Reserved category of seat,
- G. PWD/ SAP Certificate, if allotted under PWD Category,
- H. Documents to claim seat for Ward of Defence Personnel, EWS categories and Ward of Jammu & Kashmir Migrant.
- I. For OBC (NCL)/EWS categories, certificates need to be produced for the current year.
- J. Candidates allotted seats under the domicile/resident category seat are to submit Permanent Residence Certificate (PRC).
- K. A Gap Certificate (Self declaration legal document through court affidavit) must be submitted at the time of document verification only by candidates who have a break of 1 or more years between their last completed qualification and the new admission at NLUJA, Assam. This gap certificate must be printed on non-judicial stamp paper and attested by an authorized Notary Public or an Oath Commissioner.

- L. Annexure 1-A and Annexure 1-B must be duly notarized on non –judicial stamp paper of Rs 100/- by an authorized notary public or an authorized oath commissioner.
- M. Annexure-II (Medical Certificate) must be signed by at least a state or central government-registered MBBS medical practitioner before submission by the candidate.
- N. Annexure – III (Temporary Undertaking Form) is required if any original testimonial from Sl. No. A to J is unavailable. This annexure is valid only for a limited time, as specified within the form. Candidates must submit the self-attested photocopy of their original testimonials to the university before this validity period expires.
- O. Annexure – IV (Hostel Accommodation Application Form) must be signed by the candidate and their parent and then submit it at the time of document verification.
- P. Annexure – V (Local Guardian Form) must be signed by the candidate's local guardian and submitted by the candidate at the time of document verification. In the absence of a local guardian, the candidate's parent must sign the form.
- Q. Annexure-VII (Anti Ragging Affidavit): A printed copy of the undertaking, submitted online by the candidate and their parent, must be presented at the time of document verification. The link for the online undertaking is provided within the annexure.

Important Note: Apart from Annexure 1-A, Annexure 1-B, and the Gap Certificate affidavit, all the annexures (applicable to both P.G and U.G) can be printed on standard A4/A5 size paper.

- Orientation Programme: 2026–27 will be held from August 5 to August 8, 2026, at the Seminar Room, Floor II, Administrative Block of the University.
- Students shall bring along formal wear. It is mandatory to be formally dressed on all official occasions.
- Class Timetable and Academic Calendar, Odd Semester, Academic year 2026-27 will be uploaded shortly to the University website.
- Students are advised to attend classes regularly in order that the University prescribed attendance mandate is fulfilled. Failing which, students shall be detained in the instant semester.
