The National Law University and Judicial Academy Assam recently held the 5th Capacity Building Moot Court Competition, an important intra-college event. The test was followed by a draw of lots and an exchange of memorials. The method of draw of lots was used to form the fixtures of the oral rounds. The Oral Rounds of the competition took place on 19th February (both the Preliminary rounds were conducted that day) and finally on 21st February, the Valedictory Ceremony of the event took place The event concluded with the announcement of awards recognizing outstanding participants.
