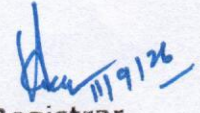

Terms and Conditions:

1. The sealed envelope should bear the following superscription on the top: "The Registrar, National Law University and Judicial Academy, Assam",
2. Each firm/agency/vendor/individual shall enclose a valid identity/residential proof, such as a Trade Licence, PAN Card, or Aadhaar Card. A self-attested copy of the same must be submitted along with the tender/quotation.
3. Each firm/agency/vendor must have its registered office within Kamrup Metropolitan or Kamrup District.
4. The successful bidder shall be required to deposit the entire sale consideration through NEFT/online payment immediately upon weighing of the old newspapers and determination of the sale amount. The newspapers sold shall be collected within two days at the bidder's own cost and responsibility.
5. The successful bidder shall weigh the newspapers using a digital weighing machine only, and the weight recorded therein shall be treated as final.
6. The University reserves the right to impose any other condition deemed just, fit, and proper at the time of bid evaluation or issuance of work order.
7. Any firm/agency/vendor/individual found indulging in any malpractice or adopting any unfair means shall be barred from undertaking any work with the University.
8. The past record and performance of the firm/agency/vendor/individual shall be duly considered while awarding the work.
